- A notarized high school transcript must accompany the application.**
- One letter of recommendation from a counselor, teacher or former employer
- As part of the application, you are required to compose and submit an essay. The essay should be no more than one page, typed with a font size no smaller than 12 point, and double spaced on 8 ½ x 11 paper. Include your name on the top right hand corner of the essay.
